Children's Summer Reading Club Rules and Prizes

The children's reading club is for birth through fifth grade. Children receive a game board when they sign up, then read or listen to KHCPL books and earn prizes! Listed below are the rules and a point scale for the children's program.

1. Bring your game board each time you visit the library or bookmobile.
2. It takes 12 points to reach each level. To earn your points, read or listen to books appropriate to your reading level.
3. Only library materials earn points.
4. One level (up to 12 points) may be counted per day for reading done in the library or on the bookmobile.

1 point	Easy/Picture Books (Fiction/Nonfiction), Easy Readers (Fiction/Nonfiction), Audio Books (E/PIC/ER)
2 points	Middle Reader, Juvenile Nonfiction, Biographies, Audio Books (Middle Reader), Juvenile Graphic Novels, Older Readers, Picture Books, Magazines
3 points	Juvenile Fiction, Junior High Books, Young Adult Books and Graphic Novels, Adult Books, Audio Books (Juvenile, Junior High, Young Adult)

Limit 2 books per child. Prizes available while supplies last.

Once children complete their game board, they may continue to earn prizes by participating in the Read-On Program. For each completed column on the Read-On game board, children will be allowed to select a prize from the Read-On prize box.

All points must be redeemed by 5:30 p.m. on Saturday, August 1, 2009.
